**Rider University Tomorrow's Teachers Program
IND-101 Introduction to Education
Memorandum of Understanding**

1. Your high school must register for Rider University Tomorrow's Teachers Program by completing and **emailing** the Memorandum of Understanding/Articulation Agreement (see attached) to Dr. Tracey Garrett at **tgarrett@rider.edu** by Friday, September 10, 2021. As soon as I receive your MOU, I will confirm your school's enrollment by email. If you do not hear from me, please assume that I did not receive your form and contact me ASAP so you can still enroll by the deadline.

2. Once your school has registered to participate in the program, your students will have the opportunity to participate in Rider University's IND-101 Introduction to Education on-line course, which allows them to earn three (3) college credits and the option of attending on campus events during the academic year. Each student who would like to earn college credit must complete the Student Registration Form and pay the \$250 course fee. Once the teacher has collected all of the student registration forms and checks (made payable to Rider University), the teacher will create a typed cover sheet listing the names of the students who are participating in IND-101 Introduction to Education and mail the registration forms and checks by Friday, September 24, 2021 to:

3. The special pricing for IND-101 Introduction to Education is \$250 (earning three (3) college credits). This course price includes all fees and online resources. All participating students in Rider University's IND-101 Introduction to Education may request student identification cards and are entitled to use the campus libraries, online resources, and computer labs.

4. Through this partnership, Rider University credit will be awarded to students who earn a grade of B or better in the Tomorrow's Teachers course in their high school, complete additional assignments for Rider University college credit and pay the \$250 fee. All high school instructors who collaborate with the Rider University Tomorrow's Teachers Program must hold a master's degree or gain approval from the Rider University Department of Teacher Education.

5. If the student attends Rider University School of Education, IND-101 Introduction to Education will be accepted as general elective credit toward graduation. Students may list courses taken at Rider University as college courses on most college applications. It will be at the discretion of the receiving institution to accept or deny these credits.

6. At the conclusion of your academic year, the participants in IND-101 Introduction to Education will receive a final grade. The grade will be recorded on an “official” transcript. Students will then submit a transcript request form obtained from the Rider University website in order to receive an official transcript listing the IND-101 Introduction to Education course.
